Renewable Energy in the Community Award

Recognising projects or initiatives that demonstrate meaningful engagement with local communities and deliver lasting social or economic benefits. This award celebrates organisations that place community partnerships at the centre of renewable energy development and help ensure transition creates positive outcomes for people across Ireland.

Responsible Energy Leadership Award

Excellence in Renewable Energy Supply Chain Award

The award focuses on the **practical execution and delivery of renewable energy infrastructure**, rather than advisory or project development support.

Grid Innovation & Delivery Award

The award focuses on the innovation itself and its impact, rather than the delivery of a specific project or the provision of standard supply chain or advisory services.

- Organisations applying innovative approaches within renewable energy

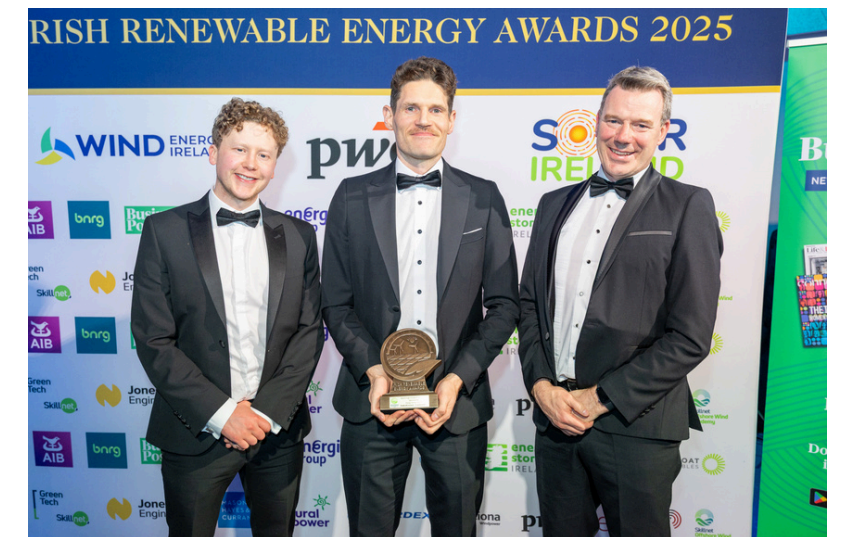


Energy Storage Project of the Year Award
